## HISTORIC LIVING AT IDYLEASE

There is something to be said for modernization but there is also something to be said about a structure that has preserved a piece of living history which provides an affordable place to live.

Living at Idylease offers old world charm harking back to the popular resort hotel era that took place at the turn of the century in the Highland Region of New Jersey.

Each room at Idylease has been meticulously restored to reflect the time when Idylease first greeted guests on New Years Day in 1903. Rooms are furnished with period decor and recall a time that celebrates the tradition of gracious hotel living.

The Historic Preservation Commission of the Township of West Milford declared Idylease its first locally designated historic landmark on October 5, 1988. Guests over the years have included Thomas Edison who stayed here while working on a magnetic ore extracting device at the Franklin/Odgensberg Mine for the New Jersey Zinc Company.
